RATINGS FORMING PART OF AN ENGINE ROOM WATCH CERTIFICATE

Title	APPLICATION FOR RATING FORMING PART OF ENGINE ROOM WATCH CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION
Objective	To ensure that the requirements of Regulation 23 of the Merchant Shipping (STCW) Regulations are fulfilled.
Scope	All applications for examination received from engine ratings
Responsibility	Examination and Certification Section
References	Regulation 23 of the Merchant Shipping (STCW) Regulations, Regulation III/4 of the STCW Code
Forms	APPLICATION FOR A RATING FORMING PART OF ENGINE ROOM WATCH CERTIFICATE

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Age : Not less than 18 years of age.
2. Seagoing services : Have completed approved seagoing service for a period of not less than 9 months; or
3. Education and training: Approved pre-sea training or special training for a minimum period of 2 months and approved seagoing service for a period of not less than 6 months.
4. Meet the standard of competence specified in section A-III/4 of the STCW Code and as set out in Rule 18 in the Third Schedule, of The Merchant Shipping (STCW) Regulations, 2002 as amended.

- 2 Seafarer Discharge Book.
- 3 Attested true copy of Passport (pages showing applicant's photograph and particulars)
- 4 2 passport size photographs
- 5
 - (a) Basic Safety Training Certificate.
 - (b) A Valid Medical Fitness Certificate.
 - (c) Ship security awareness Training.
- 6 Evidence that an approved training programme has been followed throughout the specified period of the seagoing service; and that all service while on board ship was performed in a satisfactory manner. (Completed Training Record Book may satisfy this requirement)
- 7 A statement to be produced from Chief Engineer under whom they have served, that at least 6 months of the last 12 months of their seagoing service have been spent as part of an engineering watch in the engine room under the supervision of the Chief Engineer or a qualified Engineer officer.
